On-Street Parking Program 2017- Proposed Changes to St. Clair Gardens BIA

Date: June 20, 2017

The Toronto Parking Authority (TPA) has undertaken a review of its On-Street Paid Parking Program for 2017. As a result, the TPA is proposing a number of adjustments to the hourly rates and hours of operation to the on-street paid parking spaces.

Background

On-street paid parking is important in order to better manage a parking space. On-street parking spaces are typically the most conveniently located, serving areas of high demand and are meant to serve short-stay parkers (considered less than 3 hours at most times).

Changes to the hourly rate and hours of operation for on-street parking spaces are key tools in fairly allocating and managing this scarce resource, by encouraging high turnover and availability of the on-street parking supply.

Proposed Changes

You are receiving this notice because the proposed changes will impact the on-street paid parking spaces in the St. Clair Gardens BIA, specifically the hourly rates are being proposed to change as follows:

Implementation

These adjustments are being submitted to the Government Management Committee on September 25, 2017. The agenda for the meeting will be posted online on September 18, 2017 if you wish to review the full report. If adopted, the item will be considered at the City Council meeting on October 2, 2017. The aforementioned changes are scheduled for implementation between Fall 2017 and Spring 2018, upon approval.
