Streetcar rail replacement

St Clair West Station ramps

Date: Thursday, August 4, to Tuesday, August 9 2016

Work description and purpose

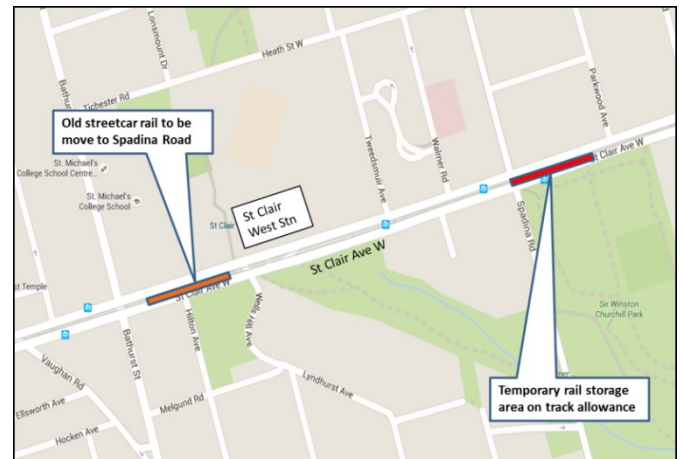
Streetcar rail replacement will take place within the west streetcar ramp at St Clair West Station. TTC crews will be working around the clock through Thursday, August 4 to Tuesday, August 9 in order to complete rail installation.

Work activity

Starting on Thursday, August 4 at approximately 9:00 a.m., a TTC track crew will be transporting pre-welded rail from storage at Spadina Road to the St Clair West Station streetcar ramps for installation. The assembly of the new track will include rail cutting, rail welding, and fastening the rails in place.

Work hours

Track installation is completed on a 24/7 basis in order to lock-in the concrete effectively to preserve long term strength of the rails and maintain the project schedule. Efforts will be made to keep noise levels to a minimum as much as possible. Construction vehicles are equipped with a back-up alarm, and staff will do their best to limit the reversing of vehicles during the night work. All rail work in the west ramp will be completed by August 9. After hours work is required to support the daytime construction and complete the project as quickly as possible.



TTC service and traffic

There will be no changes to TTC service or traffic as this activity will take place within the TTC track allowance. All bus routes will follow regular service.
