## Street Level Elevator Closed

Due to streetcar platform work in the walkway near McDonald's

**Start date: Overnight work begins at 6 a.m. on Friday, October 21 to 6 a.m. on Monday, October 24, 2016**

### Streetcar Passenger Loading Platform Rehabilitation (ongoing until December 2016)

- Between October 21, 2016 and October 24, 2016 crews will be working around the clock to install a water proofing membrane to protect the concrete in the walkway near the McDonald's Restaurant. The street level elevator will be closed during this time.
- Waterproofing systems help to reduce the water infiltration into the station in winter and rainy conditions.

**No access to the Street Level Elevator at St Clair Station from at 6 a.m. on Friday, October 21 to 6 a.m. on Monday, October 24, 2016:**

- **Access to the elevator will be closed from the street level. Customer Service staff will be on hand to direct those who require access to the elevator.**
  - Elevator service at Pleasant Boulevard (entrance, elevator, concourse):
    - From 6 a.m. Friday, October 21 to 6 a.m. Monday October 24, 2016, the elevator at St Clair Station will only operate between the subway platform and Pleasant Boulevard, due to construction.
    - From Pleasant Boulevard, customers can board a 512 St Clair shuttle bus to St Clair Avenue West.
  - Elevator Service at St Clair Avenue East (entrance, en route to elevator):
    - From 6 a.m. Friday, October 21 to 6 a.m. Monday October 24, 2016, the elevator at St Clair Station will only operate between the subway platform and Pleasant Boulevard, due to construction.
    - From St. Clair Avenue East, customers can access the buses and the elevator to the subway, one block south on Pleasant Boulevard, or board an eastbound 512 St Clair shuttle bus at the Blue Night stop outside of the station.

### Work hours

The curing of the concrete is dependent on weather conditions; crews will work around the clock in order to expedite the work.

### Noise, vibration

Noise and vibration associated with construction is expected. Efforts will be made to keep noise levels to a minimum.

### Transit Service

In order to provide service to customers requiring an elevator during this work, the 512 St Clair shuttle buses will **temporarily** stop at the 312 Blue Night stops (during the daytime) at the St. Clair Avenue West and Yonge Street intersection.
